

MOLD PREVENTIAN CHECKLIST



STOP WATER DAMAGE



Repair leaking pipes



Check your home's gutters and roof drainage



Make sure there's adequate slope leading away from your home



If you have a crawlspace, consider covering dirt with plastic

CONSIDER REPLACING VULNERABLE MATERIALS WITH MOLD-RESISTANT ALTERNATIVES. THESE MAY INCLUDE:

- Tile
- Stone
- Luxury vinyl flooring
- Galvanized or stainless-steel fixtures
- Waterproofed wallboards and adhesives



KEEPING YOUR HOME OR BUSINESS DRY

Invest in dehumidifiers or set your air conditioner to reduce indoor humidity

Ideally keep the humidity in your home below 40 percent

Cold surfaces that are insulated are less likely to form condensation



BE VIGILANT

- Always be on the lookout for mildew or mold smells in your home
- Frequently disinfect high-risk rooms like bathrooms and laundry rooms
- Mold can form in air ducts, attics and wall cavities
- If you suspect there is mold growth behind walls you should check or call a mold remediation professional to run tests
